- ADP expanded into two more countries in 2019: Bhutan & Burkina Faso
- Funding to ADP remained stable in 2019-2020 at approximately 1 million per annum
- ADP is pivoting to greater use of digital platforms in era of COVID-19



Gender Dimensions of NTDs



- Discussion paper on gender dimensions of NTDs jointly developed by UNDP, TDR, Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine
- Launched in November 2019 at ASTMH
- Cited twice in Lancet, successful webinar (600+ registrations) held on World NTD day 2020
- Ghana and Senegal planning to integrate some recommendations from the paper into NTD programmes

- UE is a platform launched by the Government of Japan, ADP and the GHIT Fund, to connect funders, innovators & access stakeholders working in LMICs
- First Global Dialogue held in Bangkok (January 2019) followed by two technical dialogues held in NYC (September 2019) on:
 - Integrating access and delivery considerations into R&D
 - Strategies to increase financing for access & delivery
- Second Global Dialogue held in Bangkok (February 2020)
- UE will be launching a series of knowledge products over the next several months via webinars
 - First planned webinar is a landscape of funding & financing opportunities for access and delivery (July 2020)
